1. LEGAL STATUS

China Education Association, HKUSU is established in Hong Kong and registered in accordance with the provisions of section 5A (I) of the Societies Ordinance.

The registered office of the Association is located at The University of Hong Kong, Pokfulam Road, Hong Kong.

The principle activities of the Association are advancement of education for students in Mainland China.

2. PRINCIPAL ACCOUNTING POLICIES

(a) Basis of preparation

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in Hong Kong and comply with accounting standards issued by the Hong Kong Institute of Certified Public Accountants. They are prepared under historical cost convention.

(b) Taxation

No provision for Hong Kong Profits Tax has been made as the Association is exempted from taxation under Section 88 of the Inland Revenue Ordinance.

(c) Revenue

The revenue of the Association is recognized on cash basis.
